
PRESCHOOL BIBLE PRESENTATION

THIRST TO THRIVE WOMEN'S GROUP BEGIN NEW STUDY Tuesdays, 11:30am


The Thirst to Thrive women's study group is beginning a new study, *Better: A study of Hebrews* by Jen Wilkin.

Have you noticed the parking lot looking quite full at times throughout the year? We have, too! For the last 6 months, we have been working hard with engineers, contractors and the Town of Prosper to find a solution. While the goal is to have permanent parking that aligns with our campus expansion, a temporary parking lot answers the more immediate calland at a fraction of the cost! After many iterations and strategic considerations, we are about to get underway. This project will add 122 spots to our already existing 117, thus more than doubling. This will be enormously beneficial for events, busy Sunday mornings, and busy weeknights with multiple ministries and outside groups meeting at once. This also opens up new possibilities for expanding

our ministries and outreach in creative and helpful ways.


Because of savings during the construction project in 2022 and the continued generosity of many, this parking lot budget of \$204,500 is completely covered. We give great thanks for your continued financial support of PUMC's ministry, and we give great praise to God for the blessing to expand them for the sake of many. What an amazing church this is!

The parking lot will be constructed using a helpful new geogrid product that is used for stabilizing soft subgrades and reinforcing trafficked surfaces. On top of that will be a layer of recycled D-2 flexbase and then a layer of

asphalt millings. All of this will be highly compressed for a smoother finish.



Don't be surprised when you come by and see construction equipment and progress already being made. The project will take approximately a month to complete. We will be posting pictures along the way.
