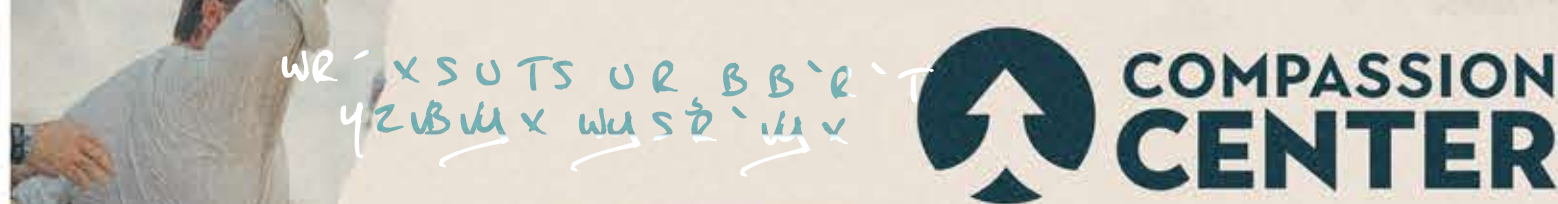

There is a growing trust among families who see our church as a safe, welcoming place for children with special needs. Through Hope for Christmas, we welcomed several first-time families, including one who attended specifically because they had heard about our special needs kids ministry. Their five-year-old child, who is autistic and non-verbal, was supported by a buddy in our sensory room and did exceptionally well. His mother shared that their family had not attended church in years because many churches could not accommodate her child. Experiencing a space where he was welcomed and supported was deeply meaningful and impacted the faith of their entire family. Stories like this reflect the true heart of this ministry. While numbers tell part of the story, our greatest measure of success is families feeling seen, supported, and able to fully participate in the life of the church.

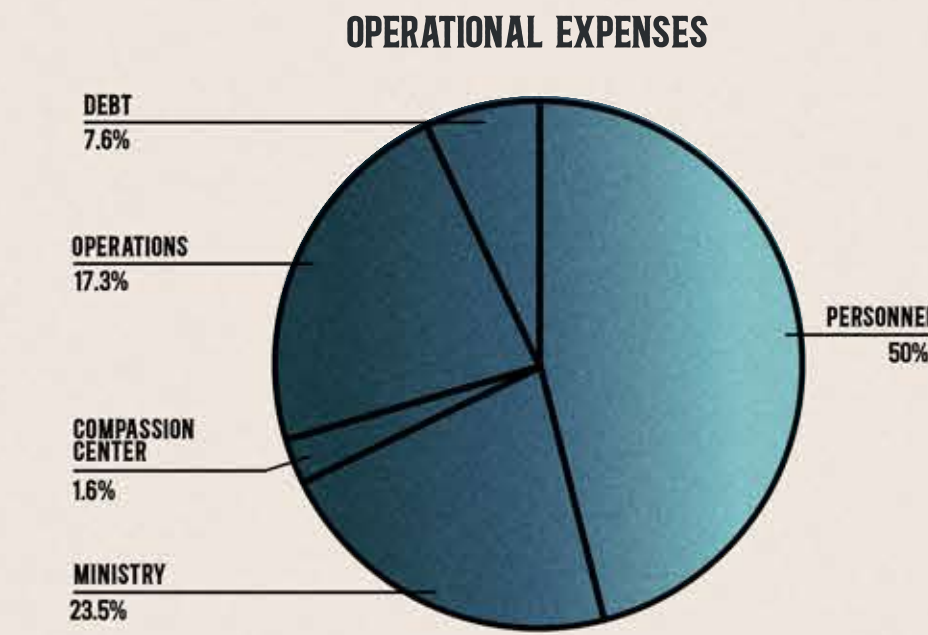
