



Spring Semester 2026 Course Descriptions

CORE CLASSES

Essential Beliefs: Have you ever wondered why we believe what we believe as Christians? Do you struggle to articulate your faith and how to explain your beliefs to someone easily? This class is designed to introduce to you the fundamental beliefs of being a Christ follower. The foundational beliefs introduced in this class are based on Crosspoint City Church doctrinal statements. Our hope is that this class will give you a foundation to grow in your understanding of these beliefs and understand how they practically apply to our lives as Christ followers.

God's Grand Narrative: The Bible is such a big book and for someone not familiar with it, it can seem intimidating and confusing. The goal of this class is to make this book less intimidating as you understand how the Bible fits together and the grand themes of the greatest book ever written. Our hope is that this class will give you a foundation to grow upon in your understanding of the Bible so you can feel comfortable in reading God's Word, knowing how it all fits together.

Rooted: Rooted takes people on a 10-week journey of learning how to know and follow Jesus. Students will learn foundational Christian beliefs and practice the 7 rhythms of discipleship observed in Acts 2 throughout their time together to challenge and inspire one another to step beyond their comfort zone as they follow Jesus. This class is a great opportunity for new believers to grow in their walk with Christ.

BIBLICAL STUDIES:

Old Testament Studies: The foundational way we get to know God is by reading the words He has given to us. This becomes the basis for developing a deep relationship with Him. He has given us sixty-six books to read and our focus, in this class, will be on the first thirty-nine books, collected together as the Old Testament. The Old Testament is important to help us understand who God is, our need for Christ, and give us the necessary background for understanding the New Testament and biblical prophecies.

New Testament Studies: The foundational way we get to know God is by reading what He has given to us. He has given us sixty-six books to read and our focus, in this class, will be on the last twenty-seven books collected together as the New Testament. We will delve into the New Testament at a level that will familiarize you with these books and give you a foundation for further study and comfortably navigate the New Testament.

THEOLOGICAL STUDIES

Theology 102: This is the second of four courses in a general survey of Bible doctrine designed to introduce the student to the major areas of systematic theology. This course presents the following areas of doctrine: the doctrines of the person and work of Christ (Christology), the Holy Spirit (Pneumatology), and salvation (Soteriology).

Theology 104: This is the final of four courses in a general survey of Bible doctrine designed to introduce the student to the major areas of systematic theology. This course presents the following areas of doctrine: the doctrines of the Church including its structure and purpose (Ecclesiology) and the doctrine of the End Times and Eternal State (Eschatology).

LIFE & ELECTIVE

Medieval / Renaissance Church History: This class covers the development and expansion of Christianity from Alfred the Great and Charlemagne to the birth of Martin Luther. Focus will be on the continued development of theology and church practices, the historical context that shaped and influenced many of our modern theological, and political beliefs in regard to Christianity in the United States today.

Financial Peace University: God calls us all to be good stewards of our lives and the resources He trusts us with, including our finances. Financial Peace University gives you the lessons, tools, and community needed to take control of stewarding your money effectively and faithfully throughout your life.

Bridges out of Poverty: This is a meaningful, eye-opening class that helps people who aren't living in poverty better understand the daily challenges and hidden rules that shape others' economic realities. It offers tools, clear insights, and new ways of thinking making it easier to communicate with, support, and empower individuals working to build stability and long-term change.

The Emotionally and Spiritually Healthy Woman: God's desire is to bless each believer with an abundant life, dwelling richly in an intimate, loving relationship with Him through His Son, Jesus Christ. This course offers a journey that will equip the participant with concepts and tools to gain insight and understanding of how personality and temperament, the communication process, one's image of God, unhealthy relationships, and boundaries all contribute to or impede the journey to emotional and spiritual health.

Alpha: This Alpha Course is an introductory exploration of the Christian faith designed for those who are curious, seeking answers, new to Christianity, or wanting a refresher on the basics. Over a series of interactive sessions, Alpha creates a relaxed, open, and welcoming environment where participants can discuss life's big questions and explore who Jesus is, why He matters, and how faith impacts everyday life.
