ICEBREAKER

Share a favorite Easter memory.

CONTEXT

Our scripture for today helps us see that because we are found in Christ we are free from the penalty and the power of sin in our lives.

PASSAGE

Romans 6:1-14

DISCUSS

- Why is the resurrection of Jesus considered the greatest event in human history and what impact does it have on our lives?
- In what ways have you experienced new life or transformation in your own life as a result of the resurrection?
- How does the concept of union with Christ affect our understanding of our salvation?
- What are some practical ways you can remind yourself of your union with Christ and its implications in your daily life?
- In what ways does Christianity differ from other religions in regards to achieving righteousness and new life?
- How does this difference between Christianity and other religions impact your relationship with God and your life choices?

DISCUSS CONTINUED

- What does it mean to be dead to sin, and how does this truth apply to our lives as believers
- How can we practically live out this truth of being dead to sin in our daily lives and decisions?
- Using the scripture from Romans, how does our future hope as believers provide motivation for how we live our lives?
- In what ways does knowing your future hope in Christ influence the way you live your life today?

PRAYER

- Begin by sharing any prayer requests or concerns
- Ask God to help us apply these verses to our lives throughout the coming week
- Pray for the ability to surrender every area of your life to Jesus in faith and receive new life from Him
- Pray that you can live from the victory that Christ has brought you and to live fully alive
