What is a memorable (funny or significant) memory from elementary school?

CONTEXT

This week Pastor Blake Odgers taught on the life and legacy of King Josiah and how we can reflect these same convictions in our own lives. King Josiah's reign is recorded in 2 Chronicles chapters 34-36 and 2 Kings 22-23. For more details on King Josiah check out page 2 of the study guide.

DISCUSS

- As you look back on your family lineage is there anyone who has made a spiritually significant impact on you and your family?
- How did King Josiah's actions make a generational impact, even though his reign seemed to end prematurely?
- Can you think of actions you could take in your own life that may have a positive effect on future generations?
- How does Ephesians 2:1-3 highlight our former state of spiritual death and the need for renewal?
- Can you share a moment when you realized your need for spiritual renewal or recognized your former state of spiritual death?

DISCUSS CONTINUED

- Why is it important for believers to be transformed as it says in Romans 12:1-2? How can we present ourselves as living sacrifices?
- As we have been in our All To Him Discipleship Journey, how have you experienced transformation or growth in your relationship with Jesus?

PRAYER

- Ask God to help us recognize His calling in our lives and to respond with obedience and willingness.
- Ask God to help us consecrate ourselves to Him fully, surrendering our lives and seeking His cleansing and forgiveness.
- Ask God to renew our minds and transform us, enabling us to discern and align with His good, pleasing, and perfect will.
- Thank God for those that left a spiritual legacy in your life and pray for the ability to leave a positive legacy for future generations.

FACTS ABOUT KING JOSIAH

1st Year of Reign (8 years old): Josiah becomes King of Judah after the death of his father (2 Chronicles 34:1).

8th Year of Reign (16 years old): Josiah begins seeking the LORD with all his heart (2 Chr. 34:3).

12th Year of Reign (20 years old): Josiah begins to purify the land of all idol worship (2 Chr. 34:3-7).

18th Year of Reign (26 years old): Josiah begins to repair the temple (2 Chr. 34:8); He finds the Book of the Law (2 Chr. 34:14); He leads the kingdom in repentance and covenant renewal (2 Chr. 34:19-33); He re-establishes the Passover Festival and leads the kingdom through it for the first time in over 400 years (2 Chr. 35:1-19).

31st Year of Reign (39 years old): Josiah finishes restoring the Temple (2 Chr. 35:20); Dies in battle (2 Chr. 35:23-24)
