READ

Ask the Holy Spirit to help you understand the scriptures as you start reading Luke 12:13-34. Interact with the text by underlining any repeating words and circling words or phrases that stand out to you. Read through these scriptures at least two times.

EXAMINE

- In Jesus' parable, God asks who the things are for that have been stored up. How would you answer that question if God were to ask you: who are the things you have stored up for? Why is the answer an important one for us to know?
- How much of your anxiety is tied to concerns about you? How can you trust God more, and how does that help you to worry about yourself less?
- Jesus tells us that our heart will follow our treasure. Have you experienced that to be true in your life? What do you honestly treasure most in life? If it's not Jesus, how can you treasure Him and His kingdom above all?

THE POINT

WE CAN STORE UP EARTHLY TREASURE OR SEEK AFTER THE KINGDOM OF GOD, BUT WE CAN'T DO BOTH. WHERE IS YOUR TREASURE STORED?

APPLY

Take what God has shown you through your time in His Word, and apply it to your life this week.

- Write out a prayer asking God to shift your heart to find your ultimate treasure in Jesus and His kingdom.
