



WHAT TO BRING AND FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What to Bring

- Bible and pen (you will NOT be able to use your phone Bible app)
- Change of clothes for Saturday and Sunday
- Shoes/clothes for Rec and Mission Project
- Toiletries
- TOWEL AND WASHCLOTHS (Don't forget these)
- Sleeping bag and PILLOW
- One bag of snacks and a drink



What if I have to leave for part of the weekend?

Our hope is that you will be able to stay for the whole thing. If you must leave for a short time, your PARENTS must fill out a "Time Away Card". You can download and print this card on our website, paulann.org/outpour or you can fill out a card at the kick-off party. This card allows you to leave for a period of time and then come back when done. It must be signed by a parent. (Example: basketball game)

When does Outpour BEGIN and END?

Students will arrive at their assigned host home on Friday night between 6:30 - 7:00 PM. Please eat dinner before and do not arrive before 6:30.

An address to the home will be provided at the kick-off party.

Outpour will end after the 11:00 service on Sunday morning.

Can I have my phone at Outpour?

We want all students to be fully present throughout the weekend without the distraction of a cell phone. We suggest leaving your phone at home, as all cell phones will be collected once you arrive at your host home.

If students need to contact a parent during the weekend a phone will be provided by their leader.

Rules and Expectations

Each student will be expected to abide by rules and expectations that create a safe environment for all Outpour participants. Safety expectations include, **no all-nighters, no sneaking out, no pranks**, no cell phone usage, and students with cars will be expected to turn in their keys to their leader for the weekend.
