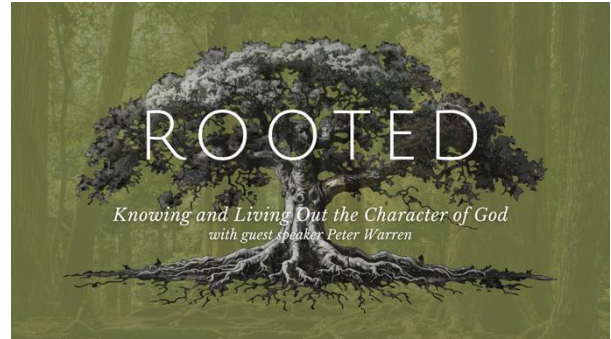


# Discipleship Group SERIES QUESTIONS



## *Rooted*

### Message Series

This three-week series invites us into a simple but powerful journey: to know God, grow in God, and show God to the world. Through the story of the prodigal son, we discover the true heart of our Heavenly Father—personal, compassionate, and full of grace. From there, we see how God uses life’s challenges to shape our character and deepen our faith. And ultimately, we learn that the clearest evidence of Jesus is found in how we love one another—because when we live in authentic, Christ-centered community, we become a visible witness to a watching world.

### WEEK 1 Background

What is God really like? Through the story of the prodigal son, this message reveals the heart of the Father—just, patient, generous, and quick to forgive. As we confront common misconceptions and the barriers of comparison and unworthiness, we’re invited to experience a God who is deeply personal and full of love.

- What is God teaching the people in the passage?
- What is the Holy Spirit teaching you personally?
- What will you do with what God is teaching you?

### WEEK 1 Questions

- Look at verses 17–20. What does the father do before the son can “prove” anything? What does that tell us about how God responds when we turn toward Him?
- Compare the responses of the younger son and the older son. How do *comparison* and *feeling unworthy* show up in their attitudes?
- The father is described as just, patient, forgiving, generous, and personal. What keeps people today from fully believing these things about God?
- How would your daily life change if you truly believed God is personal and delights in you? What would look different this week?
