In 2002, it was introduced by the Office of Child Development and Early Learning (OCDEL) to improve, support, and recognize a continuous quality improvement efforts of the early learning programs in Pennsylvania.

The Keystone STARS program is managed by the <u>Pennsylvania Department</u> of <u>Public Welfare</u> and is further administered by six "Regional Keys" or child care resource developers in the state of Pennsylvania. A Keystone STARS designation informs parents and caregivers that their children are in a safe, positive environment that supports their current and future academic and personal growth.
