SUNDAY SCHOOL FOR CHILDREN (preschool – 5th grade)

Sunday school is available during both the 9:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. services. Children can meet their teachers in the Narthex beginning 5 minutes before the start of worship and will walk to the Sunday school classroom together once the service begins. After their lesson, the teachers walk the children back to the sanctuary to reunite with their families.

Every Sunday, breakfast is provided in the youth room during the 9:00 am worship. Come anytime and join us for the 10:30 am contemporary worship. 
