**OUR LITURGICAL CALENDAR.** Today begins the most sacred week of the Christian calendar with **Palm Sunday, Good Friday,** and **Easter.** It is no surprise these New Testament events coincide precisely with the Old Testament dates of **Passover, the Feast of Unleavened Bread,** and the **Feast of Firstfruits.** What is called “Passover” in modern times combines all three into an eight-day celebration lasting this year from April 1 to 9. Passover’s commemoration of deliverance out of bondage first required selection of a spotless lamb; this is **Palm Sunday.** When Jesus arrived triumphantly in Jerusalem (John 12:13) it was as though God was saying to His people, ‘I am providing THE most perfect Lamb for the sacrifice - will you choose Him?’


Our Lamb was slain and buried on **Good Friday/Passover** to take away the sins of the world. Jesus was without sin (leaven) and is our bread of life (John 6:35). On Passover Jews offered the first ripe barley to the Lord to dedicate the harvest. A marked sheaf was bundled and left standing in the field. The next day the sheaf was cut down and prepared for the offering on the third day, when the priest waved the sheaf before God. This is Resurrection Day, **Easter,** when Jesus rose again, defeating death as the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep (1 Corinthians 15:20).
