**OUR LITURGICAL CALENDAR.** Thirty days before Passover is the **Feast of Purim**, celebrated by Jesus in John 5 and recognized by us beginning on **Tuesday, March 2nd**. It is also called the Feast of Lots because lots were cast to determine the best date for a planned genocide of Persia's Jews around 5 BC. Queen Esther's faithfulness in relying on God's guidance and her courage to speak to the king on behalf of her people foiled the plans - the date of annihilation instead became the date of deliverance.
