Fall 2022 September Sunday School Lessons & Questions

September 4: Faith on Display in Hard Times (James 1:1-12)

Main Point: God uses trials to mature your faith.

- What are some common trials and difficulties we might experience in today's world?
- What keeps us from seeking God's wisdom when we face trials?
- How does focusing on eternity change the way you respond to trials?

September 11: Faith on Display in Your Relationships (James 2:1-13) Main Point: Don't play favorites.

- Where do you see favoritism or discrimination today?
- Why is the heart of God so close to the poor and the excluded?
- How can we actively demonstrate God's love to everyone?

September 18: Faith on Display in Your Actions (James 2:14-26)

Main Point: What you believe is seen in what you do.

- What are some characteristics of a faith that is alive?
- How would you describe the connection between faith and obedience?
- what sometimes keeps us from living out our faith?

September 25: Faith on Display in Your Conversations (James 3:1-5a, 9-10, 13-18) Main Point: When you rely on God, your words reflect His character.

- What are some of the consequences of an uncontrolled tongue?
- How do our words give others a glimpse into our souls?
- How does heavenly wisdom differ from earthly wisdom?

Fall 2022 October Sunday School Lessons & Questions

October 2: Faith on Display in Facing the Enemy (James 4:1-10)

Main Point: In Christ, you can have victory over sin, the world, and Satan.

- Where do you see evidence that the world is hostile to God?
- How can we love people in this world and yet not be friends of this world?
- What does it look like to draw near to God?

October 9: Faith on Display in Your Priorities (James 4:13-17; 5:7-11)

Main Point: No matter what lies ahead, continue to trust God.

- How can we find the right balance between making plans and trusting God for our future?
- When have you faced some type of persecution because of your faith? How did you respond?
- When have you experienced God's compassion during hard times?

October 16: Why We Need God's Word (2 Timothy 3:1-5, 13-17)

Main Point: The Bible gives direction about how to follow God and work with others.

- Who has modeled for you what it means to live according to God's Word?
- What does this passage teach us about the Bible?
- Why we can trust the Bible?

October 23: Hear God's Word (Nehemiah 8:1-3, 7-12)

Main Point: Seize opportunities to hear God's Word proclaimed and exclaimed.

- What sometimes keeps us from hearing God's Word?
- When have you found it difficult to understand what the Bible was saying?
- Who are Bible teachers in your life that you trust, and why?

October 30: Study God's Word (2 Timothy 2:14-19, 22-26)

Main Point: Regularly studying God's Word keeps us firmly grounded.

- What might get in the way of regularly studying God's Word?
- How have you experienced God's Word transform your life?
- Why is it important to study **and** apply the Bible's teachings?

Fall 2022 November Sunday School Lessons & Questions

November 6: Meditate on God's Word (Psalm 1:1-6; Philippians 4:8)

Main Point: Saturating our minds with Scripture keeps us focused on the things of God.

- What does it mean to delight in God's Word? How is it connected to true happiness?
- What is it that you delight in the most?
- What are some ways we can encourage one another to memorize Scripture?

November 13: Obey God's Word (James 1:19-27)

Main Point: We display the truth and value of God's Word as we live it out.

- What is humility? How does being humble help us obey God?
- Why might we hear God's Word but not act on it?
- How can we encourage one another to be doers of God's Word?

November 20: Communicate God's Word (Deuteronomy 6:1-9)

Main Point: Knowledge of God's Word should not be kept to yourself -- pass it on.

- When have you struggled to trust or obey God?
- What aspects of your faith are easy to talk about? Why?
- Who has God put in your life to "pass on your faith" to?

November 27: Reasons for Giving Thanks (Psalm 107:1-9)

Main Point: Give thanks for the ways God is at work in your life.

- What has God given you that you're thankful for?
- What do these good things tell us about God?
- How can we be thankful to God in the hard seasons of life?
