Arrival

- Check-in is **July 8-10 from 9:00-9:30 AM** at the entrance behind the cross (look for the balloon rockets!).
- Your child will receive a color-coded wristband, and you'll receive a matching security sticker for pickup.
- Please leave water bottles, toys, phones, and other extras at home.

Parents are welcome to stay for the opening assembly in the Chapel. Once we dismiss into squadrons, only approved volunteers may remain.

During Space Mission

- Be prepared for a little mess! Day 1 includes colorful powdered chalk during Big Fun, Day 2 will involve water games, and Day 3 will be a combo of those things.
- The front doors will be locked from **9:45-11:00 AM** for security.
- Pickup begins at **11:30 AM** at the same check-in location. After your security code is verified, you can wait in the Worship Room while kids finish closing assembly.
- Please stay for lunch each day! Sandwiches, chips, fruit, and cookies will be provided, with sun butter and gluten-free options available. Parents and siblings are welcome.

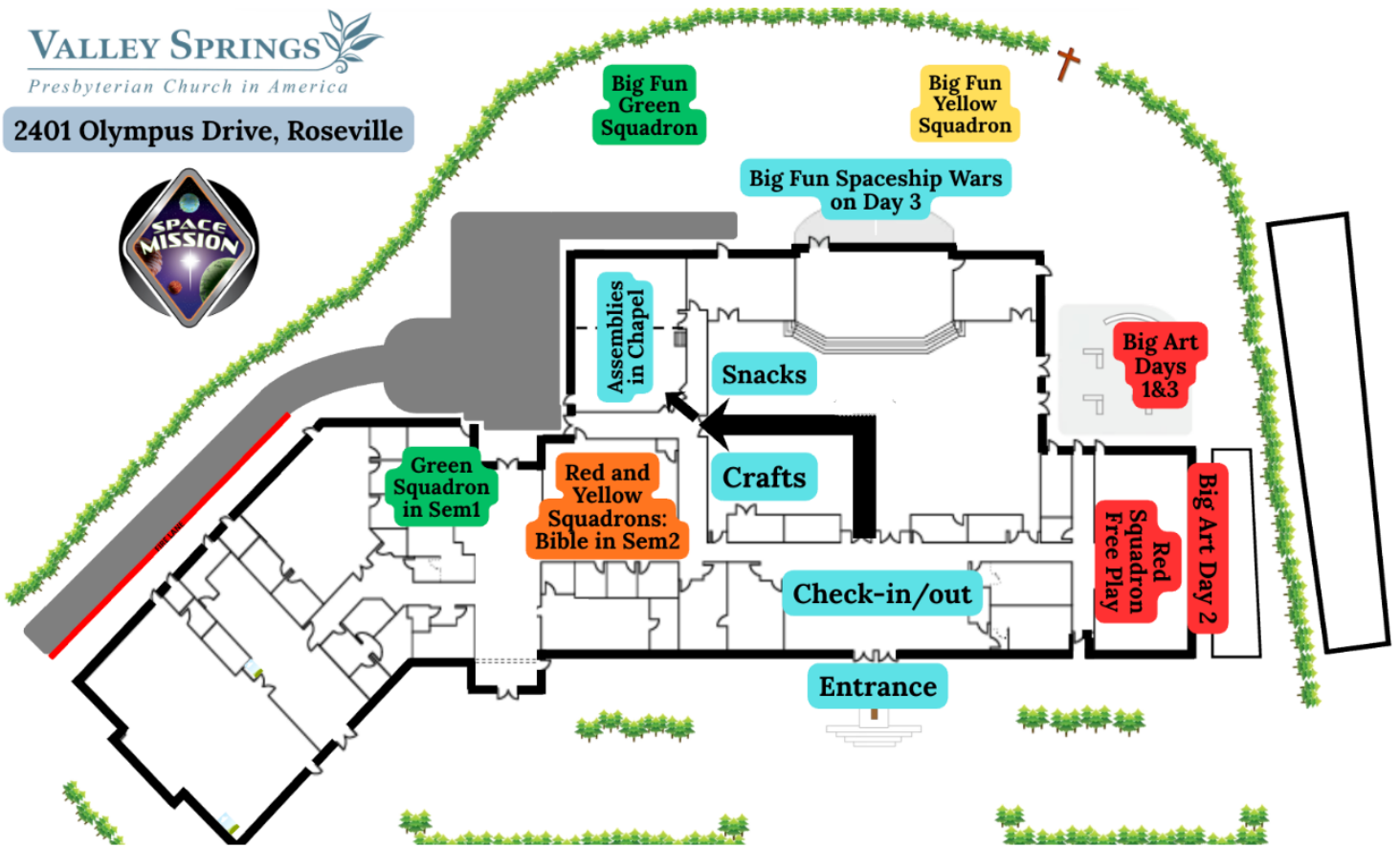
A Few Reminders
