Five Stages of One Parish Planning



May 2025



Parish Family Advisory Council formed with equal representation from each parish.

July & August 2025



Household Census Survey to understand "Who are we?" 688 households, 1900 parishioners participated.



Parish-wide input Discipleship Survey to understand "What we believe" 1243 parishioners participated.

September & October 2025



Listening Sessions held to validate survey results and inform future planning.

February 2026



Father Brad's Pastoral Letter is released. Key decision: both parishes stay open.

March - May 2026



Draft vision statement and initiatives created based on Parish Leadership Team and parishioner input.



July & August 2026

All parishioners will have an opportunity to share their feedback and input on the draft parish family initiatives. There will be in-person and virtual options to accommodate wide participation.



As we continue to move towards finalizing our One Parish Plan, our parish family has already been experiencing moments of spiritual growth and unity.

2025

- Lent — Hosted *The Rescue Project* as a parish family experience
- June — Consecrated the parish family to Jesus through the Immaculate Heart of Mary
- August — Developed and delivered a homily series on Discipleship
Launched an annual Alaska Adventure Youth Retreat initiative
- October — Developed and delivered a homily series on the Universal Call to Holiness
- November — Hosted the three-night adult Parish Family Mission, *Fully Alive in Christ*
- December — Established a parish family Hallow prayer partnership and digital prayer community

2026

- January — Developed and delivered a homily series on the vocations
- Lent — Organized 33-hours of continuous Eucharistic Adoration at the beginning
- May — 60+ couples participated in the *Evermore in Love Marriage Retreat*
