MESSAGE DISCUSSION GUIDE

1. Think about a relationship in your life where conversation feels natural, open, and ongoing—where you don't worry about saying the “right” thing, but just stay connected.
 - a. What makes that kind of connection feel safe and real?
 - b. What if you had a conversation with God that felt more like that kind of relationship, how might prayer look different?
2. Read Jeremiah 29:13. This verse speaks about seeking God. How does this connect to the idea of prayer as an ongoing, open conversation instead of something formal or distant?
3. Read Ephesians 6:18–20. In verse 18, what does this passage say about the frequency and type of prayers God wants us to come to him with?
4. Read Matthew 7:11. What does this teach about God's heart toward those who come to Him? How might this change the way you think about asking God for help, guidance, strength, understanding, etc?
5. The PRAY pattern includes praise, repentance, asking, and yielding. Which of these feels most natural for you right now, and which feels hardest? Why?
6. In Ephesians 6:19-20, Paul asks the church to pray for him and his ministry team, standing in the gap when they are tired or overwhelmed. Along with praying for the ministry leaders of our church, who is one person you could begin praying for regularly this week?

Prayer is way less formal than some of us are trying to make it, but it's way more constant than many of us are experiencing. Being in constant communication with God through the Holy Spirit is way more accessible and dynamic than most of us realize. So don't hang up the phone!
