




Times, Talents, + Treasures (8th)

MESSAGE DISCUSSION GUIDE

1. Share a time when you made a mistake either unintentionally or intentionally that you once felt guilty about. What happened? What made it hard to forgive yourself?

2. Read Luke 5:17-26.
 - a. What efforts did the paralyzed man's friends do to get him to Jesus to be healed?

 - b. How do you think the paralyzed man felt when Jesus told him his sins were forgiven rather than immediately healing his body?

3. Jesus chose to forgive the man of his sins first to reveal what he would do on the cross for all people, which was a greater gift. Read the following passages about forgiveness and discuss what you're learning - Romans 3:23-24, Acts 10:43, 1 John 1:9, Isaiah 23:45, Colossians 2:13

4. Sometimes when we're holding onto guilt, shame, or regret from a past sin, we wonder if God will forgive us. We put conditions on ourselves such as "I have to show up at church enough" "I have to resist temptation consistently" "I have to be a better person" for God to forgive me. What is one condition you have a tendency to put on yourself as you wonder if God will forgive you?

5. Read Romans 5:8. God's love for us is so great that while we were still dead in our sin, Jesus died for us, putting us in a right standing with God before we ever had a chance to be a "better person" or to clean ourselves up. How does this change our perspective that we need to do something to be forgiven?

6. What would you tell a friend who is struggling with guilt, shame, or regret about the forgiveness Jesus offers them?

7. We all have friends riddled with guilt, covered in shame, living with regrets even if we don't realize it. Who comes to mind that you can share the forgiveness of Jesus with this week?
