MESSAGE DISCUSSION GUIDE

1. Think about a time when something felt discouraging or shaming. Maybe it felt suddenly profound or crushing, more than the situation warranted. What was that experience like? How did it affect your trust in God?
2. We're in the middle of an unseen war. A spiritual war began with Satan's rebellion against God, angels choosing sides, and Satan being defeated and thrown out of heaven along with the angels (demons), who followed him. From that point on their mission is to wage war against humanity. If they cannot beat God's angels in Heaven they will try and destroy God's creation on earth. Read Revelation 12:7-9, 17. How do these passages paint a picture of what was happening in heaven and on earth (women=Mary, baby=Jesus, dragon=Satan)?
3. Jesus' death and resurrection decisively won the war against sin, death, and the devil, yet ongoing spiritual battles continue to affect daily life until Satan is thrown into hell when Jesus returns. Believers are called to be strong in the Lord's mighty power, not their own. Read Ephesians 6:10-17.
 - a. According to this passage, where does true strength come from, and why does that matter in everyday struggles?
 - b. Look at each piece of armor. Describe what is protected and how when we wear the armor (ie helmit of salvation protects your mind, etc)
4. The full armor of God equips believers to stand firm against the enemy's schemes by clinging to Jesus and living faithfully in Him. Give some examples of what putting on this armor may look like (prayer, scripture, etc).
5. Spiritual struggle often shows up in subtle and ordinary ways rather than dramatic moments, such as discouragement, temptation, or conflict, etc. Which piece of the armor feels most needed in your life right now, and what would it look like to intentionally "put it on" this week?
6. What is one concrete step you can take to rely more fully on God's strength instead of your own?
