MESSAGE DISCUSSION GUIDE

1. Have you ever felt convinced you weren't the right person for something God was leading you toward? Maybe a job, parenting, leading a group, leading a ministry. What made you feel that way?
2. Read Judges 6:11-18, 36-40. Gideon is certain God is calling the wrong guy.
 - a. What three reasons does Gideon give for believing he cannot rescue Israel? (vs 13, 15)
 - b. In verses 17, 36-37, and 39, Gideon asked for a sign 3 times. When God calls us into something bigger than us, why are we so quick to doubt God and ourselves?
 - c. How did God answer him each time he doubted? (v.14, 16)
3. Gideon built an army of 32,000 men, ready to fight the Midianites. Yet God said that was too many. Read Judges 7:2-8. Why would God reduce his army to a ridiculous number of 300 men?
4. God wanted Gideon to win the war, not by his own strategy and strength but by God's power so he would know beyond a shadow of a doubt that his confidence is always in God. God want's that for you too! In what ways have you seen God do something you couldn't, and you knew for certain it was by his power not yours?
5. God sent Gideon and his men to surround the enemy camp at night with only trumpets and torches. The enemy was confused and turned on each other or fled. Gideon didn't have to be enough because God is enough.
 - a. Is there an area of your life where you have been waiting until you feel more capable before taking a step of faith?
 - b. What might trusting in God's presence look like instead?
6. Jesus says in Matthew 28:20 "Surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." As God helps you learn to trust in his presence, what step of trust might he be calling you to take today?
