MESSAGE DISCUSSION GUIDE

1. Have you ever watched a toddler who wants to exert control? They want to feed themselves, walk where they want to go, and have a tantrum when they don't get their way. Describe the length you've seen a toddler go to be in control.
2. While it's an important life skill for toddlers to learn to be independent, adults often show the same need for control, whether it helps or not. What does it look like in adult life to exert our need for control?
3. Read John 12:12–16 and Matthew 21:7–9. The people welcomed Jesus like a king - waving palm branches (honor) and laying down cloaks (surrendering authority and pledging their lives).
 - a. If we had a king in this country, what would make it hard for you to pledge your life and lay down your authority to him, and why?
 - b. How is Jesus different from earthly kings? See Isaiah 40:11, Psalm 86:15, and Matthew 11:29.
4. Jesus carries you when life is out of your control. He redirects you when your efforts to be in control falter. As you submit to Him, when you stop leading your own life and trust Him to lead instead, He meets you in deep ways. How have you seen God meet you when you've submitted to Him? Describe your situation briefly and how God moved in your heart and circumstances.
5. Jesus is better at being King of our lives than we are. Why? When we lay down our cloaks and submit to Jesus, giving Him authority in our lives,
6. He calms the fight in us. Bringing peace, clarity, and growing trust as we see Him working on our behalf. What keeps you from trusting God?
7. When Jesus leads, life becomes fuller—not easier necessarily, but more grounded in peace and purpose. What is one specific step you can take this week that follows His lead instead of your own?
