MESSAGE DISCUSSION GUIDE

- Marriage is hard. Two people learning to live together is challenging. Consider the marriage of someone you know, parents, grandparents, friends. What have you seen in their marriage that helped make it strong?
- 2. Our reading today on marriage is challenging. Sometimes scripture makes us uncomfortable, especially when we don't fully understand it or others have misused it. Yet we are not to avoid the challenging scriptures. With that in mind, read Ephesians 5:21-33. What is your first reaction to this scripture?
- 3. The key verse to this scripture is verse 21. We are to submit to each other in a way that honors Jesus.
 - a. Think back to Jesus' life. In what ways did he treat others with respect?

 4. Paul is directing us to submit as husbands and wives on an equal level. No

- 5. In this passage, Paul is talking about Christ and the church (v32). Keeping in mind Jesus' sacrificial love for us, the church, re-read verse 22-30. What are you seeing and hearing in these scriptures? What do you still wrestle with?
- 6. Husbands lead the way in Christ-like submission toward their wives. Wives follow their husband's modeling of submission and submit to their husbands in a Christ-like manner. How does this point to Jesus as we honor our spouses and Him?
- 7. Make a commitment today: If you are married, in what ways will you commit to submitting to your spouse? If you're not married, in what ways will you model submission to your married family or friends?
