MESSAGE DISCUSSION GUIDE

- Think about a time when work gave you a knot in your stomach or left you discouraged. What was that season like, and how did it shape the way you approached your job?
- 2. In America today, we don't condone slavery. Neither does God. Yet in the first century Roman empire, those who were in a financial crisis chose indentured service to a wealthy household over becoming destitute. Paul addresses how followers of Jesus are to approach work. Read Ephesians 6:5–9.
 - a. Verses 5-8
 - i. How is an employee (slave) to treat their boss (master) and why?
 - ii. What does it look like when you obey them as if you are serving the Lord?
 - b. Verse 9
 - i. As a boss, how are you to treat your employees?
 - ii. What would it look like practically to treat your employees with humility, fairness, and compassion?
 - iii. God is master to both of you. How does that knowledge change your attitude toward your boss/employee, even when they are challenging to work with?
- 3. What if work filled you up instead of draining you because you were working for the Lord and you reported to Jesus. How would that change your whole perspective?
- 4. Whether you lead others or work under someone's authority, what specific step can you take to serve with a Christ-shaped heart this week?
