MESSAGE DISCUSSION GUIDE

1. We've all heard the expression, "If it's too good to be true, it probably is." Can you think of any real-life examples or experiences where you were duped?
2. Read Luke 24: 13-24.
 - a. Why do you think the disciples didn't recognize Jesus right away?
 - b. The disciples heard from their friends that Jesus' body was gone, and angels said He had risen from the dead. Can you understand their disbelief, or would you have believed your friends?
3. Cleopas and his friend had hoped for an earthly King who would redeem Israel and otherwise overthrow the Roman government. Have you experienced a "we had hoped" moment? A time when you had hoped, wished, or prayed for something that didn't turn out as you expected?
4. Even if our prayers are not answered exactly as we had hoped and even if we don't recognize Jesus in our pain, He is still walking with us. Read 1 John 5: 4-15, Isaiah 65:24, and James 4:8. How does this make you feel?
5. When are you most likely to miss seeing Jesus' presence in your life? When you're busy? In pain? Dealing with grief? Worried about finances? Overwhelmed with responsibilities? Is there anything we can do to recognize that Jesus is walking with us?
6. Can you think of a time when you didn't see Jesus while you were walking through a challenging or difficult situation, and realized later that Jesus was with you all along?
7. Read Luke 24: 25-32. Why do you think Jesus shared and explained Scripture with the disciples before He revealed Himself?
8. Have you experienced a "burning in your heart" or another unexplained feeling before you realized that Jesus was with you? Share it with your group.
9. When we seek God, read His Word, and spend time with Him, He reveals Himself to us. As you close in prayer, ask God to fill you with a desire to spend time with Jesus so He does not become a stranger, and you consistently recognize His presence.
