MESSAGE DISCUSSION GUIDE

1. Parenting His hard work and no parent is perfect. As an adult or now as a parent yourself, what grace do you give your parents in their parenting skills? Those “I get it now” moments.
2. Read Ephesians 6:1-4.
 - a. Verse 1 – Reading in the NIV version, why is it “right” to obey your parents?
 - b. What do you think it means “obey your parents **in the Lord.**” How might that cause us to see obedience differently?
 - c. The promise is if we obey, our lives will go well.
 - i. How does disobedience to our parents as children cause our lives to not go well?
 - ii. How about when we are adults. How does a lack of honor for our aging parents cause our lives to not go well?
 - d. So, then, what does a life look like that goes well because we honor our parents? What blessings do we experience?
3. If we just look at the obedience part of this passage, we miss our responsibilities as parents.
 - a. In verse 4, what are we to avoid? Give examples of “exasperating/provoking our children. What impact does it have on them?
 - b. What does this passage say we are to do instead, and how do we practically do that?
 - c. How can you model faith formation for your children whether they are young or adults?
4. We all can relate to poor parenting practices whether from our parents or as parents ourselves. Some of us carry deep scars or gnawing guilt. Yet, Jesus died on the cross to bring you forgiveness and healing in those deep places. Take some time sharing your hurts, if your comfortable, and then pray for each other as a group.
