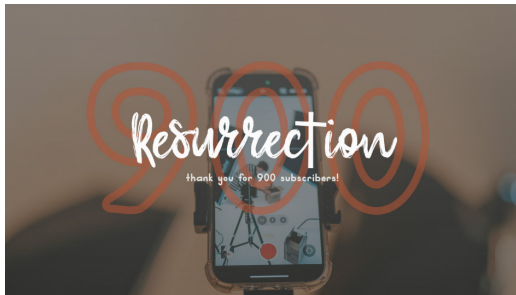

MESSAGE DISCUSSION GUIDE

1. Have you ever heard God speaking to you? Maybe it was in a Bible verse, or something a faith filled friend said, or while praying, or a worship song or message and you felt God was speaking to you? Share your experience and what you felt God was saying.
2. We've all had to learn to recognize God's voice, yet many have been coming to church for years but have never recognized what God's voice sounds like. Read 1 Kings 19:11-12, Isaiah 30:21, Romans 10:17. What does the Bible say God's voice sounds like?
3. Read 1 Samuel 3:1-10. What stands out to you about Samuel's response to God?
4. Eli was far from perfect, yet God still used him to help Samuel recognize God's voice. Who has been an "Eli" in your life—someone further along in faith who helped you recognize, understand, or respond to what God was doing?
5. Faith is not a solo sport. Why do we sometimes resist having other people speak into our spiritual lives, coach us, challenge us, or hold us accountable?
6. Don't wait for a voice from heaven but open God's Word and listen.
 - A. When you read Scripture, what helps you slow down enough to actually listen rather than simply read?
7. Samuel's prayer was, "Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening."
 - A. What would it look like for that prayer to become more than words for you?
 - B. Where might God be inviting you to listen, trust, or obey right now?
8. Is there someone God may be leading you to speak into? To guide them in their faith, help them dig into God's word, and learn to hear His voice - holding their hand until they hold the hand of Jesus? Who might that be?
