# MESSAGE DISCUSSION GUIDE

1. What's something you've been told you should do that you know is good for you—but you really don't want to do?
2. Jonah was a prophet God asked to preach to the people of Nineveh, but instead he boarded a ship and sailed 2,500 miles in the opposite direction! What are some ways people run from God without leaving town?
3. Jonah is often remembered for the fish, but the deeper issue is his resistance to God's heart. Read Jonah 1:1-3. What do you notice about what God asked Jonah to do—and why do you think he ran in the opposite direction? Have you ever known what God was asking but simply not wanted to do it?
4. Jonah didn't want Nineveh to receive God's mercy. Read Jonah 4:1-3. What does Jonah's anger reveal about his heart? Why can it be difficult to celebrate God's grace when it's extended to someone we believe doesn't deserve it?
5. We may feel justified not extending mercy or grace when someone's behavior is wrong, illegal, or even evil. What are examples of people you might find difficult to love, forgive or pray for? What makes that relationship or situation so difficult?
6. Read Philippians 2:13 and Ezekiel 36:26-27. What do these verses teach us about God's role in changing our hearts?
7. Read 1 Corinthians 13:1-3. How does this passage connect with the idea that we can do the right things with the wrong attitude? What are some examples of Christian activity that can become empty when love is missing?
8. Jonah gives us a glimpse of God's mercy, but Jesus gives us the full picture. Read Matthew 12:38-41. Why do you think Jesus connected His death and resurrection to Jonah? How does knowing Jesus—and having the Holy Spirit—give us what we need to love, forgive, and serve people we could not love on our own?
9. Who is your Nineveh? Ask God: "Show me how You see this person, and change my heart so I want what You want."
