MESSAGE DISCUSSION GUIDE

1. Have you ever had a season in life where you've needed something to look forward to in order to keep going? An illness, a hard job, etc. What was that season and did you find something that helped?
2. First Peter is written to people in a long, dark winter of suffering and he starts by putting hope on the calendar. Read 1 Peter 1:1-5.
 - a. Peter is writing to communities of believers who are living as exiles in their culture. It's hard to stay faithful in that situation. When you have hard seasons in life, in what ways do you find it hard to be faithful, trusting in God?
 - b. Peter tells them who they are. In this passage, find all the references to who we are in Christ (ie. chosen, given new birth, etc.). Look closely, there are several. Describe each one.
3. Describe the hope we have been given through Jesus' death and resurrection according to verses 3-4
4. This hope, this inheritance is nothing you worked for, it's nothing you deserve, it's nothing you've been good enough to get. It is purely a gift, an inheritance. Re-read verse 5.
 - a. Faith in Jesus and hope in the resurrection will shield you through your difficult seasons. In what ways have you seen your faith and hope as a shield to carry you through tough times?
 - b. When we get through the hard times holding tight onto hope in Jesus and staying faithful, persevering to the end, we can see it was all worth it. Share a time you felt that way and why.
5. If you are living in a tough season right now, don't interpret hardship as abandonment, God hasn't forgotten you. Practice hope every day. Read through the promises, talk about what's coming over the horizon, and stay faithful right where you are. What is one thing this week you will do to practice hope?
