MESSAGE DISCUSSION GUIDE

1. Think about a time when someone made you feel deeply welcomed, needed, or cared for. What did they do that made such an impact on you?
2. Read 1 Peter 4:7–11 together.
 - a. What stands out to you about the kind of community Peter describes?
 - b. Why do you think it can be hard to love deeply, forgive quickly, or serve without grumbling?
3. Living together in Christian community is hard and often messy. Read Romans 12:9–21 together.
 - a. What does this passage teach us about the kind of love Jesus is forming in His people?
 - b. When relationships get messy, do you tend to withdraw, keep score, defend yourself, or move toward grace?
4. The sermon asked a powerful question: “What if we stopped asking, ‘What is this going to take from me?’ and started asking, ‘What can I give?’”
 - a. Where do you see God inviting you not just to consume faith, but to contribute to the life of His church?
 - b. Where are you tempted to protect your comfort, time, or energy instead of offering yourself in love?
 - c. What gift, ability, experience, or encouragement might God have placed in you for the sake of others?
5. What is one specific way you can step into deeper community this week? Maybe it’s offering hospitality to someone, reaching out to reconcile with someone, joining a serve team, praying intentionally for someone, using a gift you’ve kept on the sidelines, or showing up to help without needing to be asked. Be specific. What will you do, and when will you do it?
