## MESSAGE DISCUSSION GUIDE

1. Holding a newborn baby is amazing, whether it's your child or someone else's. Their bodies are so small and intricate. Describe what you see in this developing newborn life.
  
2. Read 1 Peter 1:22-2:3. We become purified when we accept the truth of Jesus' gospel and when we submit to God's commands.
  - a. Purification comes through God's grace when we believe in Jesus. It comes through trials of all kinds (1 Peter 1:7). It comes through living out our faith. What has purification (a change you see in yourself you can contribute to God) looked like in your life?
  
  - b. Verse 22 What is the result of being purified (second half of the verse)?
  
3. Loving one another at times can seem simple until someone hurts you, then it's extremely hard to do. Loving others starts with internalizing God's love for us.
  - a. Why is it hard sometimes to fully internalize God's love for you?
  
  - b. Read the following verses Jeremiah 31:3, Romans 8:38-39, Isaiah 43:4, 1 John 4:19. What do these verses tell us about God's love for us?
  
  - c. Our love for others flows from God's love for us. As we seek God to help us internalize his love, we are better able to love others. We are also called to obey God and show others love. How have you experienced God's help to love others?
  
4. 1 Peter 2:2-3 directs us to crave pure spiritual milk. As we read and engage with God's word, he implants in us a hunger for more of him. In time, running to God becomes a reflex as his word is nourishment to our souls. In what ways can you start reading the Bible more every day?
