MESSAGE DISCUSSION GUIDE

1. People's perception of the role of a pastor can be different from one era to the next, from one denomination to another, and from one church to another. What has been your perception about the role of a pastor and who does the bulk of the ministry in a church?
2. The church used to believe pastors had special powers until about 500 years ago when a priest, in reading today's passage, coined the phrase "the priesthood of all believers." Pastors have a role in the church, but the ministry of the church belongs to the people of God. Read 1 Peter 2:4-12.
 - a. In verses 9, as God's chosen people, what phrases are used to describe us? What do you think each mean?
3. As a royal priesthood, every single one of us has a holy calling in the church, a part to play in the body of Christ. You are a part of what God is building right here right now, whether you know it or not, and God has a spot for you.
 - a. God gives each believer one or more spiritual gifts that equips them to serve in the capacity he directs them to. Read Ephesians 4:11-13, Romans 12:6-8 and 1 Peter 4:10-11. In these verses, in what way do we see God calling us to serve and equipping us to do so?
 - b. If you're serving in some capacity, share what it was like to be uncertain at first, gave it a try, then found God using you in ways you didn't expect.
4. In 1 Peter 2:5,
 - a. God is building us into a spiritual house. Describe what you think that means.
 - b. Offering "spiritual sacrifices" means giving of ourselves - our time, gifts, compassion, prayer, encouragement- to bless others. Looking at your own life right now, where do you sense God might be inviting you to serve or care for someone in His name?
5. God needs you here! What is one simple step you could take this week to get involved in serving?
