# MESSAGE DISCUSSION GUIDE

1. When you were growing up, what was a rule your parents had that made absolutely no sense to you at the time, but later you realized they were right?
2. Many of us first learned this story through coloring books or Sunday school lessons. Usually, the lesson was simple: "Obey God and don't do bad things." Yet Genesis 3 is about "the fall," and why it all fell apart. Read Genesis 3:1-11.
  - a. Satan's tactic is to get us to question God: "Did God really say...?" Why do you think he begins by questioning God's Word instead of directly encouraging disobedience?
  - b. Have you ever struggled with something God says in Scripture? What made it difficult?
  - c. When that happens, we have to decide: Am I going to stand OVER God's Word and argue with it, or sit UNDER God's Word and learn from it? What does that distinction mean to you?
  - d. Why is regularly reading Scripture important if we want to recognize when God's truth is being distorted?
3. According to the passage, how did the serpent tempt Eve?
  - a. In what ways are we tempted to chase what is pleasing to our eyes?
  - b. What does verse 7 teach us about our natural response to sin?
4. Ultimately, we end up trying to hide from God with busyness, walls, deflecting, etc. How does that get in the way of our relationship with God?
5. Read Genesis 3:9 and 21. God comes looking for them to cover their sin (think Jesus). In what ways have you felt God calling out for you, inviting you back into relationship with him?

**Jesus knows where to find you. Call out to Him, "Here I am, Lord. This is what I've done. This is what I can't fix and can't cover up. I need you."**

**Spend some time in prayer for each other and others you know who need Jesus.**
