

Discovering the Bible (7th Grade)


Feb 4 + 11 | 6:30 - 8pm

TEENS

MESSAGE DISCUSSION GUIDE

1. Have you ever been hurt by someone and felt a rollercoaster of emotions? Briefly share how quickly emotions can get out of control and drive us whether they are true or exaggerated. Try to stay focused on the topic of emotion and not so much on the situation.

2. Read Matthew 9:35-38. Verse 36 reveals the heart of our Savior.
 - a. In what ways have you experienced Jesus' compassion for you?

 - b. When we've been hurt, are angry, or are fearful, etc, our emotions can harass us leaving us feeling helpless to stop them. Why do you think this is?

3. Read Philippians 4:6-7. Describe how this verse speaks to God's protection and how we receive it.

4. One of the evil one's schemes is to poke at our emotions.
 - a. In what ways does he egg us on to get worked up?

 - b. How do you recognize when that's happening to you?

5. Read Isaiah 41:10, Exodus 14:14, James 4:7. What does each say about what God will do for you when you are feeling poked at by the evil one?

6. Matthew 9:37-38. We are the workers Jesus is sending out. What is he sending us out to do? (Hint: model him in verse 36)

7. Sometimes it's hard to have compassion on people.
 - a. In what ways will we need to yield to Jesus and rely on God's strength to answer his call to bring his peace into a world that so dearly needs Him?

 - b. Share some ways you can be God's messenger and reflect peace.
