3s/4s Lesson Plan - Worship Service

Sunday, July 26

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: King Jesus! (John 1:1-3; Luke 19:28-40; Rev. 19)

Activity Pages + Free Play | 9:45 - 10:15 am

One volunteer should greet children and families at the door.

ACTIVITY PAGES

Invite children to the tables and pass out the week's **Coloring Page** (in Activity Box) and **crayons** (in Teacher Box) to each child.

During free time, especially because children are at such a young age, please keep a diligent eye and ear on their words and play with one another.

GIVE EXPECTATION : Give children a **warning** before you ask them to clean up and gather:

SAY *"Everyone, in 5 minutes we are going to pick up our toys and gather together!"*

Sing the clean up song and ask children to gather in a circle.

Activity | 10:20 am

QUESTIONS ABOUT THE KING

Gather children together in a circle on the floor. Ask them the following questions and have each child (or as many want to participate) answer them:

- Who created everything? (God/Jesus!)

- What is your favorite thing that Jesus created?
- If you were a king or queen for a day, what rules would you make up?
- If Jesus created everything, then he rules everything. What are some rules that Jesus gives to us? *(commands from the Bible)*

SAY *Today we will learn about how Jesus is the king over everything and everyone! Jesus is also the eternal king, which means he will rule forever and ever.*

Lesson | 10:30 am

READ STORY: KING JESUS - THE FOREVER KING

With the children in a circle, read the **story page of King Jesus** (in Activity Box). You can show kids the **pictures** (in Activity Box) as you tell the story.

QUESTIONS

- **Did Jesus create just some things or all things?** *(all things)*
- **Did Jesus come to earth as a big, powerful ruler or as a baby?** *(Jesus humbly came to earth as a baby to rescue us from our sins.)*
- **Jesus died on the cross in our place for our sins. But did Jesus stay dead in the tomb?** *(No! He rose back to life three days later!)*
- **How does it make you feel to know that Jesus will reign forever?**

“Jesus now reigns as the forever king. He can also be the king in your heart too. When you trust in Jesus to forgive you of your sins, Jesus becomes your king! He is a good and kind King.”

PRAY

“Dear God, thank You that Jesus is the Forever King. Thank You that He made everything, came to earth to love and save us, and is alive today. Thank You that one day He will return as the King of kings. Please help us to let Jesus be King in our hearts and to follow Him every day. In Jesus’ name, Amen.”

Snack + Video | 10:40 am

Have students sit at the tables for snack time.

1. **Pass Out Snacks.** Pass out the water and Cheerios in cups. Double check for any allergies on the classroom tablet.
2. **Watch the Bible Lesson Video.** While they eat, you can play the Bible lesson video from the YouTube app on the TV (*YouTube account should be Fellowship Kids (switch accounts on the top of the left sidebar if not) > go to Library on the left side bar > Choose Playlists on the top > choose LIKED VIDEOS*).
 - a. Under the Liked Videos playlist, choose **King Jesus**.

Lesson Activity | 10:50 am

CHOOSE THE RIGHT CROWN - JESUS REIGNS FOREVER

Set-up:

- Take out the two sets of crown pictures from the Activity Box.
- Place 1 copy of each crown around the room on the floor.
- Put the matching set of 6 crowns into a bag.

How to Play:

1. Have each child choose a crown on the floor to stand beside.
2. The leader pulls one crown picture from the bag and shows it.
3. All children standing by that crown sit down next to it. That crown is now out or “removed.”
4. Continue picking crowns from the bag until only one crown is left. The children still standing by it are the “last ones standing.”

SAY: *Kings and queens on earth lose their crowns and kingdoms, but Jesus’ crown will never be taken away. He is the King of kings and Lord of lords, and His reign lasts forever.*

Worship Time OR Free Play | 11:00 am

For WORSHIP TIME:

Have children sit in a circle on the ground. On the **Spotify** app on the TV, pull up the **Preschool Worship Time** playlist.

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- For the first three songs, sing and follow the motions of the song: *Good Morning God, My God is So Big, If You're Happy and You Know It*.
 - For the next two songs - *Jesus is Alive, Jesus Loves Me* - pull out the instruments from the Preschool Worship Time box and allow children to grab them and play and dance along with the music.
 - For the last song - *Jesus Loves Little Children* - you can turn off the classroom light, have children put away instruments, sit back down on their mats, and listen quietly to help them calm back down.

Dismissal | 11:20 am

- Match the 4 digit code on the parent's tag to the child's tag
- Check out the child on the tablet by clicking the check box to the left of their name on the roster.
- Give feedback! Tell parents how the student did that morning.
