*How I sensed the Lord working in the songs, prayers,,and the overall atmosphere of the service.*

### Galatians 5:4-6, "The Only Thing That Matters."

What is the relevant context for Paul's statement, "The only thing that matters is faith expressing itself through love."?

What does Paul mean by "faith" in the phrase from v. 6 above; i.e. what/who is this faith in and why? (see also Gal. 2:20-21) And what does faith matter or "count" for?

In v. V 4 and the first part of v. 6 Paul mentions 2 things that his opponents believed really mattered/counted when it came to being "justified" or made "righteous" before God. What are these and why did these people believe they were so important?

What are some things Christians today add or link to faith in Jesus Christ expressed in loving actions as being of primary importance when it comes to our relationship with God?

What for you especially helps to engender or reinforce faith in Jesus? What are some loving actions, words, &/or attitudes that you would like to see grow in you as expressions of your faith in Jesus?
