God Delivers His People

God delivered His people by fighting for His people with great power. Trace the letters to finish the sentences about who God is and what your response needs to be.

When God delivered His people, He demonstrated that He is:

POWERFUL

GOD'S POWER MEANS HE IS ABLE TO DO ANYTHING HE WANTS. HE IS UNBEATABLE.

God delivered His people for the sake of His own:

GLORY

GOD'S GLORY IS HIS HONOR, SPLENDOR, GREATNESS, AND PERFECTION.

The only response to God's power is:

PRAISE

PRAISING GOD MEANS SAYING AND SINGING ABOUT WHO GOD IS AND WHAT HE HAS DONE.

God's people need to be characterized by:

FAITH

FAITH IS TRUSTING GOD TO LEAD AND GUIDE A BELIEVER IN LIFE.

God delivered Israel at the Red Sea, rescuing the line of the Messiah and ensuring that Jesus would be born to save sinners. As a result, whoever places their trust in Jesus will pass from death to life just as Israel passed through the midst of the sea on dry ground.




