We are excited to be able to celebrate with your family as you make a commitment to raise your child in a Christ Centered home. As your church we feel that God has called us to partner with you along this journey!

What is Family Dedication?

Family Dedication is a special commitment ceremony that takes place in front of the life of the church, usually during one of our weekend services. During the Family Dedication Ceremony families make known their commitment to raise their children in a Christ centered home in front of their faith family. Families make this commitment known by thoughtfully selecting a verse for their child and reading it before the congregation. The church in turn makes known their commitment to come alongside families and partner with them for years to come. To finish the ceremony families and the church engage in a read and response time in which they commit to God to point the Child towards Christ.

What is the commitment the family is making?

In Deuteronomy 6:4-9 we learn that the family is the primary establishment for discipleship to take place.

Parents are to act as the primary faith shapers of their children, saturating their lives and their homes with the Gospel. During Family Dedication families make known a commitment they have made to God, and are presenting this commitment to their church family.

What is the commitment the church is making?

As a Church we believe that we have a clear call to partner with Christ and families to pass faith on to the next generation. During the family dedication ceremony the church makes known their commitment to equip, encourage, and empower families to fulfill their Deuteronomy 6 call. During the Family Dedication Class, families will learn of the many ways our church chooses to carry out this call.

How do I participate?

What Family Dedication is not?

Family dedication is not a guarantee that a Child will make a faith commitment, nor should it be confused with your child's personal faith commitment. We believe that the Bible makes clear that the decision to follow Christ takes place on a personal level and involves a personal relationship with Christ. A faith decision can not be made on behalf of your child. Family Dedication is the commitment to keep the teaching and truths of Christ in front of our Kids and trusting that God will do what only He can in their lives.
