

Visiting the Cemetery



All people within the cemetery must respect the area as a sacred and reverent place. Noise and boisterous conduct are forbidden within the cemetery.

1. Do not take any plant or plant stand (used or unused) from a gravesite as it is the property of the gravesite owner.
2. Pedestrians within the cemetery are to use established avenues, walkways, alleyways, and spaces as are, or may be, provided around grave sites.
3. Children under sixteen years of age are not permitted within the cemetery unless accompanied by a responsible adult.
4. All vehicles, including bicycles, must be kept off the grass, travel at reasonable speeds on established roadways, and park in the church parking lot or on side streets where parking is permitted by the city.

5. Dogs (except for service animals), cats, and other pets are not permitted in the cemetery or on its grounds. Any pets brought to the cemetery must remain in parked vehicles.
6. The following are not permitted:
 - Intoxicating beverages, illegal substances, or chemicals are not permitted.
 - Consuming lunches, refreshments, or picnics of any kind is prohibited except as may be provided for in specific locations.
 - Loitering on the grounds or in any buildings that may be constructed on the grounds.
 - Placing or distributing any signs or notices not approved by the Cemetery Board of Trustees.
 - Peddling or soliciting the sale of any object or material.
 - Marring or defacing any landmark monument, marker, memorial, or structure; or defacing or littering the grounds in any way.
 - Hunting, feeding, or disturbing wildlife in the cemetery.
