Servant Leadership

Share about someone in your life that you would consider a great servant leader. Consider sending them a note of appreciation in the coming week.

Read 1 Peter 5:1-3, Hebrews 13:7 and 13:17

Ted shared the quote “Competency gets the job, but character keeps the job.” What are some of the main qualities that set a servant leader apart from other leaders? What are the consequences of following a leader with poor character?

Read Mark 10:42-45

Share about some specific places in scripture where Jesus modeled servant leadership. Is there a situation in your life where you are being challenged to show servant leadership?

Read Acts 6:1-4

Is delegating leadership hard for you? Why is that? Is there someone in your life who needs you to invest in their leadership?

Ted talked about how geese fly in a V formation to allow geese in the back to draft off the ones ahead of them. For this to work, the geese at the front of the formation must change out over time. How is this a good illustration for leadership in the church? What happens when a leader continues to push past the point of exhaustion?

Read 1 Peter 4:8-10

Can you share about a time when serving alongside someone else deepened your relationship with them and with the Lord?

Consider the five functions of the church (Worship, Ministry, Evangelism, Discipleship and Fellowship) and think about ways that all these functions can be carried out through serving.

Take some time to consider your effectiveness in serving. Think of some practical ways you can integrate servant leadership into your day-to-day life and share your ideas with someone else. Pray that God would provide clear opportunities for you to serve others in HIS name and for HIS glory.
