



**Who Do You Say I Am?

**Read Matthew 16:13-16**

If someone watched your life for a week, what would they conclude you believe about who Jesus is?

Why are some common “safe” versions of Jesus from our culture? What makes these versions attractive?

Jesus didn’t ask for a theory—He asked for a confession. What keeps people from answering plainly and personally, “You are the Christ”?

Are there any areas in your life where you are tempted to overthink your faith instead of obeying what you already know? What simple step of obedience is in front of you right now?

What’s one area where you have knowledge about Jesus, but you haven’t given the thought or study to move into understanding (the “why”) or wisdom (the “do”)? What is holding you back from fully embracing this truth?

What is a Bible truth about Jesus that helps you stand firm when the world around you feels shaky?

**Read Matthew 16:17-20**

Peter’s confession didn’t come from “flesh and blood.” What practices help you listen for God’s voice through Scripture instead of just repeating what you’ve heard from people?

When Jesus is confessed as Messiah, He talks about His church and the gates of hell not prevailing. How does your view of Jesus shape your view of the church? How does it shape your everyday life?
