Read Proverbs 18:21

How much do you generally think about the power of your words? Where have you seen words either build someone up or deeply wound them?

Read Proverbs 16:24

Think about a time when someone's encouragement strengthened you. How can you intentionally offer that same kind of life-giving speech to others?

Genesis 1:27

This scripture teaches that every person bears the image of God. How should this truth shape the way you treat people you disagree with or struggle to respect?

Read James 3:9-10

Is there any inconsistency between the way you worship God on Sunday and the way you talk about (or to) people during the week? Where are you most tempted to dishonor others with your words? How can you change your approach?

2 Samuel 9:1-13

David intentionally sought out Mephibosheth to show kindness and restore honor. Who in your life might be overlooked or forgotten? What would it look like for you to notice and honor them?

Read John 1:12

On a scale of 1-10 how sensitive are you to the opinions of others? How does understanding your identity as a child of God steady you when you are criticized, overlooked, or misunderstood?

Romans 12:10

This verse calls believers to outdo one another in showing honor. What would it look like for your family, group or church to take that command seriously and practice it intentionally?

Ecclesiastes 7:1 and 7:4

People often wait until a funeral to speak words of high value. If today were your last opportunity to speak to someone you love, what would you want to say? What is stopping you from saying it now?
