### **Psalm 101:1–2; Micah 6:8; John 1:14**

How can Christians live in the balance of grace and truth, without becoming either permissive or harsh? Which side do you personally tend to lean toward, and why?

### **Psalm 101:2; Matthew 7:3–5; 1 Timothy 4:16**

David begins by resolving to live with integrity in his own heart before leading others. Why is personal alignment with God essential before we try to influence our families or communities? What are some daily habits that help you maintain that personal alignment?

### **Deuteronomy 6:4–9; Joshua 24:15; Psalm 101:2b**

How do you intentionally cultivate spiritual alignment in your home? What challenges have you faced in leading family devotions, prayer, or faith conversations?

### **Psalm 101:3; Philippians 4:8; Ephesians 5:11–12**

What “worthless things” most easily creep into Christian homes? How can we practically guard our hearts and homes from these influences?

### **Psalm 101:4–5; Proverbs 13:20; 1 Corinthians 15:33**

How do our relationships shape our spiritual direction? Are there boundaries or friendships you may need to re-evaluate for the sake of spiritual health?

### **Deuteronomy 6:6–7; Colossians 3:12–17; Proverbs 22:6**

What are two or three non-negotiable values you want your home to live by? How can your group encourage one another in keeping those values active?

### **Psalm 101:8; Luke 9:23; Romans 12:1–2**

David resolved to deal daily with wickedness and maintain holiness. Why is alignment with God a daily, not a one-time, act? What spiritual disciplines (Scripture, prayer, confession, service) most help you stay centered?

### **2 Chronicles 7:14; 1 Peter 2:12–17; Matthew 5:13–16**

How can faithfulness in our homes influence righteousness in our communities and country? What specific ways can you pray for and engage with civic leaders today?
