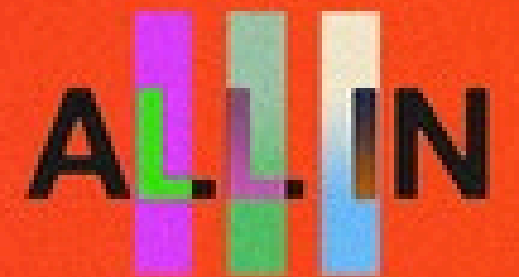
Isaiah 6:1–9 (NIV)

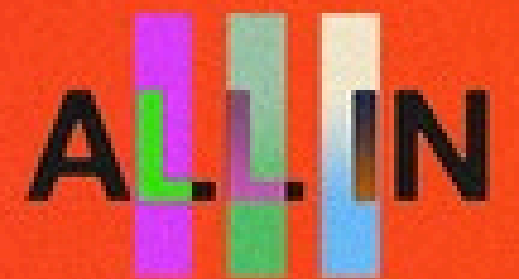
Isaiah 6:1–9 (NIV)

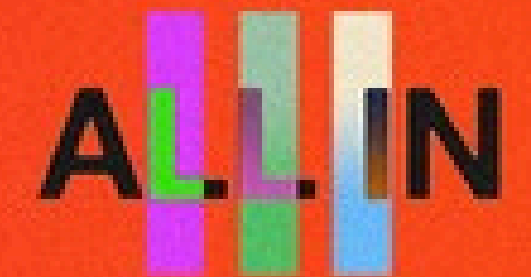
Isaiah 6:1–9 (NIV)

...not giving up meeting together, **as some are in the habit of doing**, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

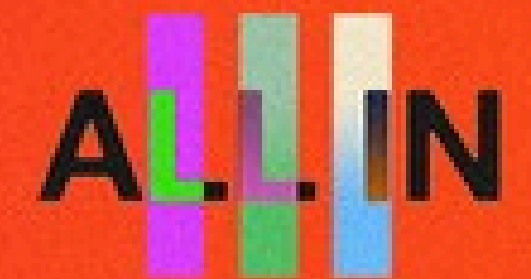


Matthew 6:31–34 (NIV)
