- The June 2023 net operating loss was \$12,025.
- The June Pledges and Envelope Contributions are up \$5,669 from May.
- Total Operations Expenses for June were \$48,812, which is \$1,602 more than May.
- Preschool Summer Camp ended the one week session with an \$875 profit.
- Total Yard sale proceeds were \$9,367.26. There are some monies still trickling in and total expenses will be finalized by July.
- At the half way point in the year, income is at 45% of the full year budget and expenses are 53% of the full year budget. Profit is falling behind budget, and expenses are over budget. It is anticipated that the last half of the year should see income and expenses more closely aligned.
