CONFESSION OF SIN | Prayers of the People

ALL: You hear us calling, You hear us calling, Abba, Father (2X)
Lord have mercy, Christ have mercy (2X)

Leader: Most merciful God, We confess that with Adam and Eve we have doubted your goodness, we have taken life into our own hands, we have rebelled against your good law and have pursued that which is forbidden and it is destroying us. So we pray:

ALL: You hear us calling, You hear us calling, Abba, Father (2X)

Leader: We confess that we have sinned against you in thought, in word, and in deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone. So we pray:

ALL: Lord, have mercy, Christ, have mercy (2X)

Leader: We have not loved you with our whole heart, and mind, and strength. We have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We have not forgiven others as we ourselves have been forgiven. So we pray:

Leader: We confess that we continually turn away from you: We turn from purity to lust. We turn from freedom to slavery, from contentedness to ever-empty greed. We turn from hope to despair. So we pray:

ALL: Lord, have mercy, Christ, have mercy (2X)

Leader: For the pride, hypocrisy, and impatience of our lives, for our laziness and self-indulgence, for the way we manipulate others to make things go our way we pray:

ALL: You hear us calling, You hear us calling, Abba, Father (2X)

Leader: For our willful blindness to human need and suffering, for shrugging our shoulders at injustice and cruelty, for the racist impulse that makes us fear the other, for our contempt for those who differ from us, we pray:

ALL: Lord, have mercy, Christ, have mercy (2X)

Leader: Almighty and merciful Father, you know our frame, that we are dust-- lifeless without your breath, lost without your finding, condemned without your grace. Create in us new hearts, give us life that we might live, through Jesus Christ our Lord. AMEN.

CONFESSION OF FAITH | A Creed for the First Sunday of Epiphany

Adapted from Isaiah 60; John 1; Colossians 1

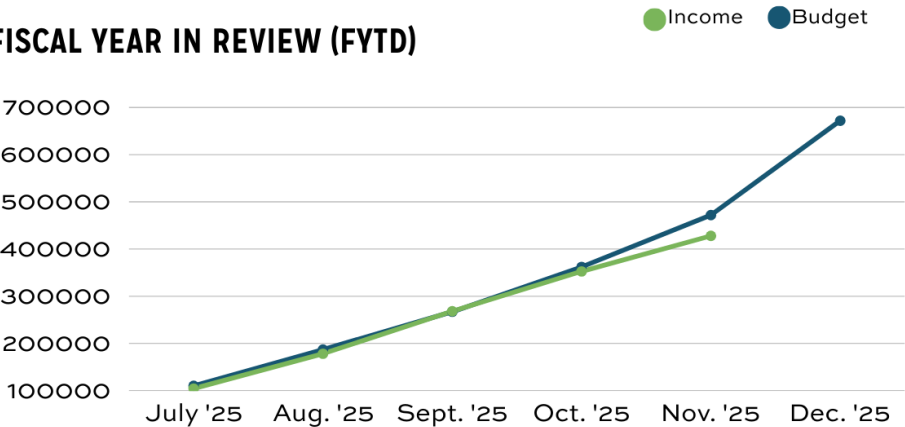
GENERAL FUND - NOVEMBER SUMMARY
