CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

All classes meet down the Children's Ministry wing - ages listed outside of the doors

This year in Sunday school, our amazing teachers will invite all children into God's big story using interactive games, reflective wondering, dramatic storytelling, catechisms and a whole lot of fun!

Before class, all K-5 will meet in our NEW Worship Room for Kids' Praise! We will enjoy praising our Creator while learning new songs, some of which we will share with the congregation in worship service throughout the year! Afterward, teachers will lead children to their grade- level classrooms for Sunday School. Parents can pick up their children from grade level classrooms at the close of the Sunday school hour.

YOUTH MINISTRY

Both will meet in the Youth House (3 houses down from the main church building on Miller St.)

Middle School Sunday School will continue to focus on unpacking the day's sermon. Whether you're an 8:30 or 11am worship goer, a great group of middle school parents will help our middle schoolers take a deeper look at the day's Scripture and applications, as we seek to understand, apply and connect to the Church body.

High School Sunday will spend time weekly imagining the most beautiful way to be human in this world as they engage with Jesus in Scripture. They will do this through "traditional" study as well as practices such as Lectio Divina.

HAND IN HAND MINISTRY

The adult hand-in-hand class is starting a new curriculum this fall called "Awe and Wonder" based on where Psalm 65:8 says "the whole earth is filled with awe at your wonders".
