## Connecting the Dots

Genesis 12 is a major turning point in the Bible and God's unfolding plan of salvation. The Lord called Abraham out of Ur and follow Him wherever He led. The Lord made a covenant with him to give him a land, make him a nation, and through his seed to bless the nations. Abraham is the first picture of justification by faith. In his old age, the son of promise, Issac, was born. God command Abraham to take his son to Mt. Moriah and offer Issac as a sacrificed. When Abraham was ready to take his son's life the Lord stopped him and provided a ram for the sacrifice. Abraham's life is all about Jesus. Jesus is the seed of Abraham who blessed the nations with salvation because Jesus is the Son given by the Father to die for our sins.
