Connecting the Dots

Joshua led Israel in the conquest of the Promised Land. He divided the land among the twelve tribes of Israel. Joshua is a wonderful prefigure of Jesus. The name “Joshua” is the Hebrew equivalent of the Greek name “Jesus.” Joshua led God’s people into victory and into the place of their inheritance. God used Joshua to fulfill the promise made to Abraham. The method of victory at Jericho is a foreshadow of the cross. In both instances the method of victory seems strange and impossible and reveals the power of God.
