Connecting the Dots

The epistles are letters written to churches in a missionary setting. Paul wrote 13 of the letters, Peter 2, John 4, James and Jude, brothers of Jesus, 1 each. The Epistles had several characteristics. They were instructional on the gospel and salvation, the nature of the church to strengthen its unity, the preeminence of Jesus, spiritual warfare, responding to persecution, and the Christian life. They were also corrective about false prophets, church conflict, moral issues, broken relationships, and unfaithfulness. The Epistles called for practical application such as love, forgiveness, church relationship, family relationships, faith, and obedience.
