Connecting the Dots

The Tower of Babel is the last of three pictures of man's continual rebellion against God. In the Fall, death came in Adam's sin. In the days of Noah the wickedness of man was so great that God destroyed the world in the Flood saving only Noah and his family. In Genesis 11, the people rebelled against God's command to fill the earth. They built a tower to stay together as one people. God's judgement was to confuse their languages and drive them away as nations. This sets the stage for the unfolding of God's plan of salvation, pointing to Jesus's death and resurrection and command to make disciples of the nations.
