David is a central story in the big story of the Bible. A shepherd, he was anointed the second king of Israel. He was a man after God's heart and was inspired to write many of the Psalms. He was a warrior king. He defeated Goliath in the name, and the power of the Lord. He led Israel in victories over their enemies. When he sinned with Bathsheba, the Lord brought him to repentance. God made a covenant with David that one of his descendants would reign as King forever. Jesus was born in the line of David and was called the son of David. God used David to point to the true and eternal King Jesus.
